



## **Tatu City Sport & Recreation Policy** *Visiting Individuals and Groups*

Tatu City is an open city which welcomes visiting (non-resident) recreational and professional athletes to use its hundreds of kilometers of trails, roads and pedestrian ways.

The rules for using Tatu City for sport and recreation are as follows:

### *Visiting Individuals*

- Individuals (and their families) may engage in sport and recreation during daylight hours only without any notification to Tatu City.
- Users must always exercise caution and obey all signage.
- Walking and running are limited to pedestrian areas (sidewalks) and prohibited on roadways.
- Inline skating is not allowed on roadways.
- Cycling is allowed on roadways only by adults, who must obey all traffic rules and signs.
- All children under the age of thirteen (13) must be accompanied by an adult.
- Standard traffic fines apply to any violators of the policy for visiting individuals.

### *Visiting Groups*

- A group is defined as five (5) or more individuals (excluding family members accompanying an individual) engaging in organized sport or recreation. Examples include a running or biking club.
- Groups are required to pay a usage fee according to the following schedule:
  - 5-9 people: KES 1,000 per person
  - 10-19 people: KES 30,000
  - 20-29 people: KES 50,000
  - 30 or more people: by agreement
- Groups are required to request access to Tatu City at least seven (7) days before their desired event date by sending an email to the address below.
- Users must always exercise caution and obey all signage.
- Walking and running are limited to pedestrian areas (sidewalks) and prohibited on roadways road verges and storm drain covers.
- Inline skating is not allowed on roadways.
- Cycling is allowed on roadways only by adults, who must obey all traffic signs.
- All children under the age of thirteen (13) years must be accompanied by an adult.
- Standard traffic fines apply to any violators of the policy for visiting individuals.
- Any route markings (i.e. chalk) used must be agreed with Tatu City in advance and removed on the same day upon completion of the sports or recreation event.

### **General Rules**

- Riders must carry a form of ID that shows their name, address and emergency contact details.
- For teams, if possible, wear the team or club kit, jersey or shirt.
- It is the rider's responsibility to ensure that their bike is in a safe condition to ride.
- Riders must wear a helmet and other relevant protective gear.
- Groups with larger numbers should split into smaller sub-groups of not more than six riders per group and distance themselves accordingly to help traffic flow. In addition, any specific Tatu City or Kenyan government restrictions in force at any time must be adhered to e.g. relating to Covid 19, etc.
- Do not litter.

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- Cyclists are not permitted to carry a passenger unless the bicycle has been built to carry one.
- For visiting groups, any prior bicycle parking requirements must be approved and should be done in such a way not to obscure traffic and other road users.

**By participating in sporting or recreational activities in Tatu City, you are:**

- Acknowledging any possible dangers of participating in cycling, running or other sports and fully assume the risks associated with it including, without limitation, the risk of collision with other riders, vehicles and fixed and moving objects, risks arising from surface hazards, equipment failure and weather conditions potentially leading to serious physical injury and/or loss of life.
- Agreeing to be aware of your own limitations, to be responsible for the condition, adequacy and safety of your equipment.
- Agreeing to hold Tatu City and its officers and other members harmless from all claims (including those resulting from negligence or omission), including claims for physical injury or loss suffered in connection with the recreational or sporting activities.
